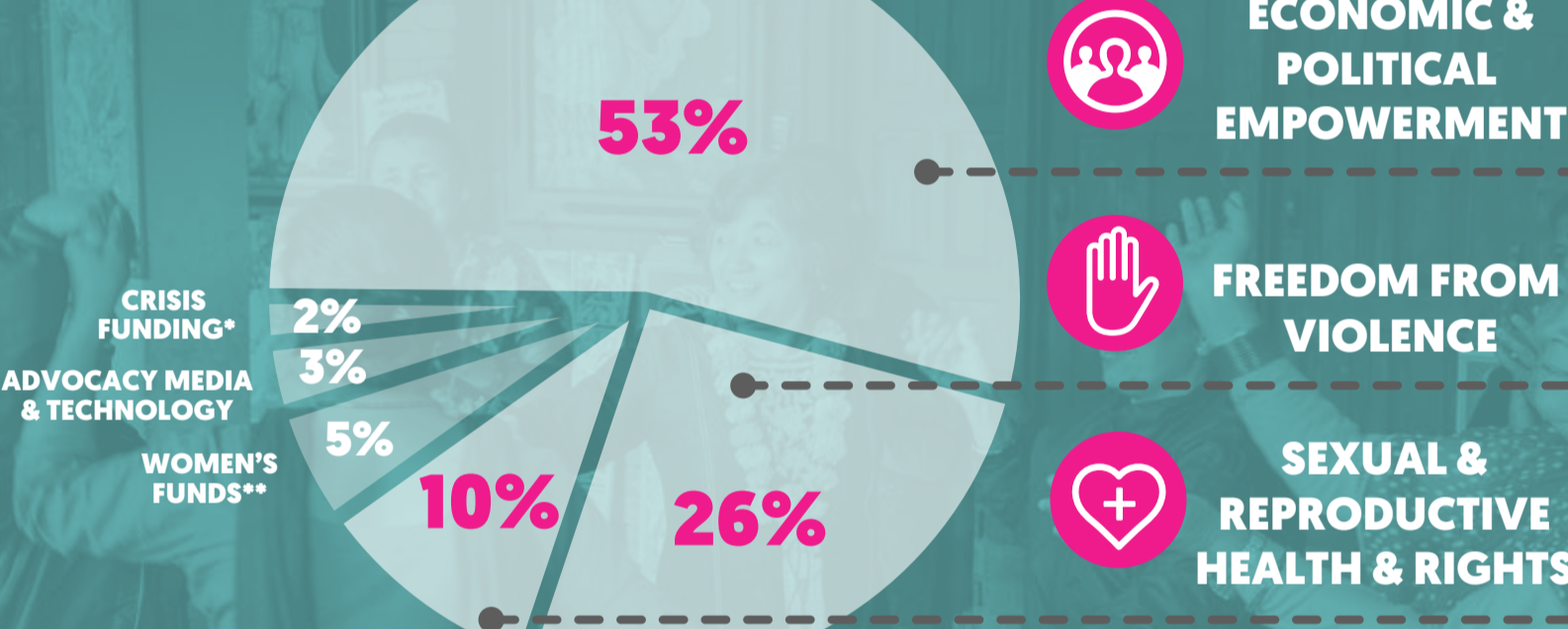

MAKING CHANGE

17 LAWS AND POLICIES CHANGED IN **12** COUNTRIES BENEFITING AN ESTIMATED **2,626,935** PEOPLE

FOR EXAMPLE:

STRENGTHENED LOCAL PROTECTIONS FOR DOMESTIC WORKERS IN JHARKHAND, INDIA, INCLUDING MINIMUM WAGE AND OVERTIME PAY

ENDED FORCED LABOR ON SATURDAYS FOR WORKERS IN THE MINES IN KAILO, DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO

SECURED MORE MONEY FOR WOMEN AND GIRL SURVIVORS OF VIOLENCE IN MAGELANG REGENCY, INDONESIA
